

4. Course Structure

Department of Philosophy has two course-structures one is Under Graduate- Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), which is starting from academic year 2017-2018, and another one is Under Graduate- National Curriculum and Credit Framework (NCCF), which started since academic year 2023-2024(under New Education Policy 2020). Both Structures has semester system. CBCS structure has 3 years degree course, whereas NCCF has 4 years degree course with both honours and research.
